GENERATION TO GENERATION CAMPAIGN FOR TOMORROW UPDATE



After two years of planning with the Master Planning Committee, which was interrupted by COVID-19, followed by months of planning and meetings with the staff, Pastoral Advisory Council, Church Finance Council, School Finance Committee, and the many ministries of our parish, it was announced in May 2022 that St. Alphonsus Liguori Parish would build a Parish Activity Center to accommodate the accelerated growth of our church and school community.

Described as a blessing from God, the ministries of our parish have continued to grow each year. This growth has far exceeded our campus capacity and is putting a strain on our current facilities and infringing on our ability to accommodate future growth.

Once again, St Alphonsus was blessed by being able to partner with our longtime church parishioners, the Firmin family, with Firmin Construction having the lowest bid. Through their generosity and cost-cutting measures by them and their sub-contractors, St Alphonsus realized hundreds of thousands of dollars in savings for this project.

The Generation to Generation Campaign was formed with the purpose of saving our parish additional expense. By paying off our construction loan ahead of time, St. Alphonsus will realize tens of thousands of dollars in additional savings by having the ability to pay our note off before its maturity. We know that there are some parishioners still prayerfully considering a contribution to this campaign, and it is not too late. This weekend, committee members will be available before and after all Masses to answer questions and pass out pledge cards.

If you haven't made a pledge yet, we ask you to consider doing so. No pledge is too small, and everyone can make a vested interest in our new Parish Activity Center. If a monetary pledge is not possible, we encourage a "prayerful pledge" for a safe and successful completion of this project. It will be so rewarding to have even the smallest vested interest in an activity that will demonstrate your support for the many ministries of our parish and our Catholic faith for Generations to Generations to come.



Respect Life - Day of Prayer for the Unborn

On June 24, 2022, the Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization decision overturned Roe v. Wade, but many state and federal laws are still hostile to preborn children. So, great prayer and advocacy is still very needed. January 22 is designated as a particular day of prayer and penance called the "Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children." In all Dioceses of the United States of America, because January 22 falls on a Sunday this year, Monday, January 23 shall be observed as a day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life.
