### Featured Saint of the Week

#### St. Bernard of Clairvaux (1090-1153)

#### Feast Day: August 20

St. Bernard was an abbot, marionist, mystic, and co-founder of the Knights Templar.

He became a Benedictine monk but as time went on he began to feel the Order was subtly changing course away from the Rule of St. Benedict. He decided some reform was warranted; the abbot was not interested.



Bernard, realizing change was not an option so he and a few other monks started another abbey in the same city of Citeaux. This new Order became known as the Cistercians. The number of monastic candidates grew; so much so, that Bernard ultimately formed more than 60 additional communities. Some who joined were not new foundations, but transferred to the Cistercians.

Bernard was considered one of the most eloquent and influential mystics of his time and therefore was often called upon from a variety of sources for a variety of issues to be resolved. A good portion of his time was spent outside of the abbey as preacher and as a diplomat in the service of the pope.

Bernard's impact on the Church was tremendous. One of his biggest triumphs was his direct involvement in resolving the schism of 1120 when 2 popes were elected; Anacletus in Rome, and Innocent II who had been exiled to France.

After a thorough investigation into the men, their affiliations, and life's work, Bernard was adamantly in favor of Innocent II as pope. Part of Bernard's invaluable work was convincing others that Innocent II was the right choice. Bernard's work along with a decision from the second Council of the Lateran finally put an end to the dispute. After a long nine year process the schism ended in 1129, naming Innocent II as the true pope.

After 40 years of monastic life, Bernard died at the age of 63. He was declared a saint in 1174 by Pope Alexander III; Pope Pius VIII designated him a Doctor of the Church in 1830.
