### Featured Saint of the Week

**Blessed Carlos Manuel Rodriguez-Santiago**  
 (11/22/1918 – 7/13/1963) **Feast Day: 7/13**

Carlos Manuel Rodriguez-Santiago was born in Caguas, Puerto Rico, the second of five children. He was raised in a very devout Catholic family. Although a lifetime of health issues plagued him, he remained passionate about educating others on the richness of the Church's liturgy, emphasizing active participation in the Eucharist and the importance of the Paschal Mystery. Although he was a layman, he was known for his deep devotion to the Catholic faith and his efforts to promote liturgical reform. Because of his love of the faith, he felt led to work in Catholic education and campus ministry, inspiring many through his intellect and spiritual insight.



Rodriguez-Santiago was particularly influential in advancing the understanding of the Easter Vigil and the importance of celebrating it in its full liturgical form, even before Vatican II introduced its widespread reforms. He shared his knowledge through articles, lectures, and personal mentorship, fostering a movement of young Catholics committed to deeper spiritual formation. Because of his health, he was not able to become a priest, but his work had a lasting impact on the Church in Puerto Rico, and he was known for his joyful, humble nature and unwavering trust in God, even as he battled cancer. He was often referred to as "Blessed Charlie."

Rodriguez-Santiago passed away from cancer on July 13, 1963 at the age of 44. His holiness and dedication to the faith were widely recognized, leading to his beatification by Pope Saint John Paul II on April 29, 2001, making him the first Puerto Rican and the first layperson in the Americas to be beatified. He is remembered for his love of the liturgy and his famous motto, "We live for that night," referring to the Easter Vigil, the pinnacle of the Church's liturgical year.

The Vatican must approve one more miracle in order for Rodriguez-Santiago to qualify for sainthood.

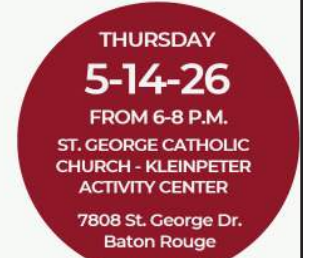

## FORMATION

### PSR Registration

Public and private school student's K-7 are required to register for PSR each year. If your child is in public or private school K-7 grade, they will need to register for religion classes. Registration for the 2026-2027 year will begin June 1, 2026. Look for registration forms on our website and in the Faith Formation Office.

### 1st Reconciliation & Eucharist Registration

Parents of 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade or older are required to register for their children for the sacraments of 1<sup>st</sup> Reconciliation and 1<sup>st</sup> Eucharist. Your child must have had one year of religion or have attended one year of Catholic school. Registration for the 2026-2027 year will begin June 1, 2026. Look for registration forms on our website and in the Faith Formation Office.

### Confirmation Registration

All 8-11 grade students that have not received Confirmation are asked to register for sessions in preparation for this sacrament. Registration will begin June 1, 2026. Forms may be found on the parish website or in the Faith Formation
