Featured Saint of the Week

Blessed Fr. Francis Xavier Seelos

(1/11/1819 – 10/04/1867)

Feast Day: 10/5

Fr. Seelos was born in the Kingdom of Bavaria, one of 12 children. From childhood he expressed an interest in the priesthood. After receiving his diploma, he went to Munich to study philosophy and theology.



The Redemptorist missionaries published a newspaper that routinely wrote about the lack of spiritual care for thousands of German speaking immigrants. He visited their seminary and decided to enter the congregation. He'd also asked to work as a missionary in the United States.

Seelos sailed into New York, arriving on April 20, 1843. It was in December of 1844 that Seelos was ordained a priest in the Redemptorist Church of St. James in Baltimore, Md. His first assignment lasted nine years at St. Philomena in Petersburg, Pa, where he served as associate pastor to St. John Henry Neumann. He also worked as the Redemptorist novice master.

During the Civil War Fr. Seelos went to Washington, D.C., and appealed to President Lincoln, asking that seminary students not be drafted for military service, although eventually some were drafted.

For several years, he preached in English and German throughout the Midwest, and the Mid-Atlantic states.

He was then assigned to St. Mary of the Assumption Church in New Orleans. His innate kindness, understanding, and responding quickly to the needs of the faithful, helped to increase his popularity. His confessional was open to all; German, French, and English.

Fr. Seelos' mission in New Orleans was destined to be brief. While he was visiting and ministering to victims of yellow fever, he contracted the disease. After several weeks he succumbed to it, dying on 10/4/1867 at the age of 48.

PSR Registration

Public and private school student's K-7 are required to register for PSR each year. If your child is in public or private school K-7 grade, they will need to register for religion classes. Registration for the 2026-2027 year will begin June 1, 2026. Look for registration forms on our website and in the Faith Formation Office.

1st Reconciliation & Eucharist Registration

Parents of 2nd Grade or older are required to register for their children for the sacraments of 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist. Your child must have had one year of religion or have attended one year of Catholic school. Registration for the 2026-2027 year will begin June 1, 2026. Confirmation Registration

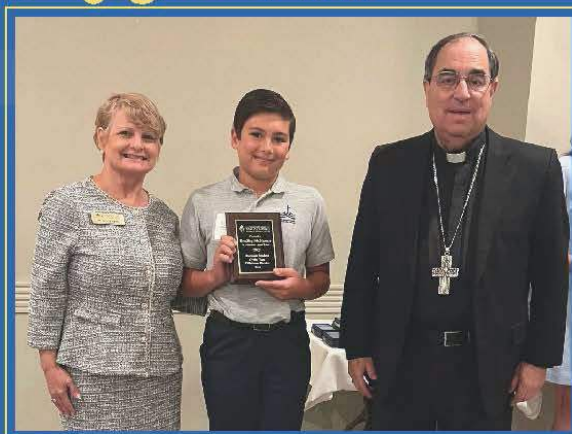
Men's Bible Study
