Fr. Jason's Wishful Thinking: Thanks for a Successful Festival!

Dear Friends in Christ.

As I pen this bulletin article, we have just emerged from "the fair weekend," and I want to take a few moments to thank those who make our two spring fundraisers (the fair AND the auction) the great successes that they are. First, let us thank the Lord God for a safe weekend with no major issues, along with mostly sunny weather that allowed the rides to operate and people to have a good time, despite some occasional showers. Since Fall 2024, I have been attending auction and fair meetings and have come to know some very creative, dedicated, and organized individuals and married couples who have large-scale fundraising down to a science, and they do it with a good sense of joy and humor.

They are aided by many wonderful church volunteers, along with school parents and students, who work together so we can all enjoy these two great events. The fair and the auction are great community-builders, as well as fundraisers for our church and school. The week before the fair, while eating lunch with the students, they were all very excited about the fair... Some couldn't even keep still when they were talking about their favorite rides! The proceeds from these events help us to pay off the construction of the Parish Activity Center (75% of the proceeds) and save for the future needs of the school (25% of the proceeds).

If I had to list the many individuals who worked tirelessly in respected areas, I would certainly leave people out. Not only do we need to thank the fair and auction volunteers, but also the individuals who bought and sold raffle tickets, as well as individuals and businesses who donated food, art, excursions, auction items, and even plants. We want to thank our sponsors who supported our bands and invested in VIP tents to help us mitigate the costs of the festival.

As we get closer to the end of the fiscal year, and after all the bills from the fair are fully paid, we will make a substantial payment on the construction loan. Then I will be able to give you a more thorough update on our loan balance and the church budget as we move into the first half of July 2025. Right now, please pray that we can plan an appropriate budget for 2025-2026 as property insurance will increase 25%, we seek to give our church and school staffs some pay increases, and the Generation to Generation capital campaign comes to a close in September.

May the Lord bless each of you for your generosity to our church and our school.

Featured Saint of the Week Our Lady of Fatima Feast: May 13

The Feast of Our Lady of Fatima is celebrated on May 13, commemorating the first apparition of the Virgin Mary to 3 shepherd children in Fatima, Portugal. There were 6 actual apparition sightings between May 13 and October 13, 1917, by all three children: Lucia dos Santos age 9, and her cousins Francisco age 8, and Jacinto Marto, age 6.

Our Lady encouraged the children to pray the rosary daily for peace in the world, and for the conversion of sinners, as well as for the end of World War I. She also asked that a small chapel in her honor, be built on the exact location of the apparitions. A small chapel, known as the Chapel of the Apparitions was built just as Our Lady requested; it was completed in 1919. Today, it is one of the most revered Catholic pilgrimage sites in the world.

Our Lady also shared 3 "secrets" with the children but they were not to be revealed. For the first secret, the children received a vision of hell, to promote praying for the conversion of sinners. The second secret was that WWI would end, but a worse war (WWII) would begin, along with the spread of communism and the persecution of the Church and Pope. The third and final secret was a vision of the persecution of the Church, including an attack on the "bishop dressed in white" (interpreted as Pope John Paul II). The first 2 secrets were revealed in 1941, the third, in 2000. The Pope had been shot on 5/13/1981, her Feast Day.

On October 13, the day of the last apparition, a large crowd witnessed a miraculous event known as the "Miracle of the Sun." This event was seen as authenticating the apparitions. The miracle was, while the sun was spinning, it turned blue, then yellow and changed in size for approximately 10 minutes. These reported visions at Fatima gained increasingly widespread attention as numerous pilgrims began to visit the site.

A canonical inquiry into the apparitions resulted in the Church officially declaring the visions in Fatima as "worthy of belief" in October of 1930. This term "worthy of belief" is how the Vatican acknowledges the event as having supernatural origin and not contrary to faith and morals. Belief in the apparition is optional and not necessary for salvation.

Divine Mercy Celebration
