Our Lady of Lourdes Feast Day: February 11

The Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes is February 11, which is the date Our Lady first appeared to Bernadette Soubirous in 1858 in Lourdes, France. Our Lady made a total of 18 appearances between February 11 and July 16, 1858. Her appearances



began shortly after the dogmatic definition of her Immaculate Conception in 1854 was released. It was after a 4 year period of inquiry that the local Bishop declared the apparitions worthy of belief.

One of the messages Bernadette received was: "Penance! Penance! Pray to God for sinners." Our Lady also told her to "Go tell the priests to bring people here in procession and have a chapel built".

"The Lady," as Bernadette called her, wore a white dress and held a rosary. The priest had wanted Bernadette to ask "the Lady" for her name. Several weeks later, on the Feast of the Assumption that she responded: "I am the Immaculate Conception."

Bernadette was devout, but uneducated and did not know what the words meant. She related the info to the priest who then informed the Bishop. In 1862, the local Bishop declared the apparitions worthy of belief.

As instructed, Bernadette dug into the mud with her hands, uncovering muddy water bubbling up, and had even drunk some of the water. When she returned to the site, the muddy water had become a full spring of clear water. The waters proved to be healing for various human conditions.

Numerous people have made claims of being cured, as a result of their pilgrimage, prayer, and the spring waters. So far, there have been 69 cases of validated miraculous healings.

By the time of Bernadette's death in 1879, a basilica had been built and consecrated on the site of the apparition.
