Saints Who Promoted Eucharistic Devotion, Magnificat

Saint Rose Philippine Duchesne
Feast: November 18



"If you have no earthly consolation, why do you not seek consolation in the heart of Jesus? To love him is truest joy."

Born in France in 1769, Rose Duchesne experienced many frustrations in her pursuit of religious life. Her family opposed her vocation. And after she managed to enter the Convent, the French Revolution forced it to shut down before she had made her final profession.

When the Revolution ended, she tried to revive her community, using her own fortune to acquire the convent properties. But that project failed, and instead she turned over the property to the recently established Society of the Sacred Heart. Soon she also professed vows under the leadership of the future saint Madeleine Sophie Barat.

Rose's ardent love for the Blessed Sacrament expressed itself in an amazing ability to remain at prayer. She frequently stayed on her knees before the tabernacle for entire nights, nourishing her desire for missionary work in America. But though she traveled to the United States, it was more than twenty years before she reached the mission territory, and when she finally did the local native language was beyond her. Unperturbed, she spent her time before the Eucharist praying for her sisters. She died in Saint Charles, Missouri. She is honored as the patroness of perseverance and against adversity.

Eucharistic Lord, May the example of Saint Rose Philippine inspire fervent love for you in every corner of the world.





