The Catholic Sacraments of Initiation

The first three sacraments, Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation, are collectively known as the Sacraments of Initiation into the Catholic Church.

BAPTISM

Baptisms for children (up to age 6) are held one weekend per month during Masses. At least one Catholic parent and one Catholic Godparent must be confirmed and in good standing with the Catholic Church. Contact the Church Office at 261-4650 for more information.



FIRST RECONCILIATION & FIRST EUCHARIST



Second graders or older are eligible to prepare for these sacraments. They will first learn to confess their sins, and later in the same year, they will receive the Body and Blood of Christ. First Eucharist is celebrated on the Second Sunday of Easter. Registration is now open for the 2023-2024 school year. Contact the Faith Formation Office at 261-4644 to register or learn more.

CONFIRMATION

Beginning in tenth grade, our teens learn more about the faith and grow in their understanding of the gifts of the Holy Spirit. The sacrament takes place in the spring of their eleventh grade year. Registration is now open for the 2023-2024 school year. Contact the Faith Formation Office at 261-4644 to register or learn more.

ADULT CONFIRMATION

Program for Catholic adults who have not completed their Sacraments of Initiation and wish to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. Confirm on Pentecost in May. Contact the Faith Formation Office at 261-4644 to join the list for Fall 2023-Spring 2024.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION (RCIA/RCIC)

Programs for non-Catholic adults or children (age 7+) to explore issues, learn about Catholicism, and decide whether to commit to Catholic Christianity. Candidates enter into full Communion with the Church on Holy Saturday at the Easter Vigil Mass. Contact the Faith Formation Office at 261-4644 to join the list for Fall 2023-Spring 2024.



Saints Who Promoted Eucharistic Adoration

Blessed Peter Vigne (1670–1740) Feast: July 8



It was toward the end of Blessed Peter Vigne's teenage years that he was transformed by a new awareness of the presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. It was this experience the led him to devote his life to Jesus.

Blessed Peter Vigne traveled a winding path vocationally. He'd joined

2 different orders of priesthood before finding his true calling, that of a traveling missionary.

In 1715, he founded the Congregation of the Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament. One of their purposes was to assure continuous Adoration of Jesus present in the Eucharist. This was soon followed by the establishment of schools to help youth grow in their faith and Christian values.

After a long and fruitful life, Blessed Peter Vigne started to experience the effects of exhaustion at age 70. Because of this, he had to step back from his missionary work and withdraw to a quiet life of prayer and reflection.






