St. Alphonsus Liguori & the Holy Eucharist St. Alphonsus Liguori (1696 - 1787) Feast: August 1

Alphonsus Maria de Liguori was born in 1696 near Naples, Italy. His parents provided him with an exceptional education in philosophy, literature, and the arts. He was 16 when he was awarded doctorates of civil and canon law. Alphonsus left the legal profession to enter the priesthood and was ordained in 1726. He adopted a style of ministry to "mission among the



people," and so began the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer, commonly known as the Redemptorists.

A very prolific writer about the Catholic Faith, he found his vocation during one of his many hours adoring our Lord. The experience and teaching of St. Alphonsus Liguori regarding the Eucharist was in line with the Pope's invitation to Christians to persevere in their most important duty: to proclaim to humanity the great mystery of God's love, especially visible in the Eucharist. Indeed, St Alphonsus was a man whose loving and continual contact with the Most Holy Eucharist enabled him to reach the highest peaks of holiness and theological understanding.

St. Alphonsus Liguori spent his last night on earth in prayer with the Blessed Mother, dying at Noon on August 1, 1787, at the age of 91. He was canonized in 1839 and declared a Doctor of the Church in 1871.

"Oh, how sweet a joy it is to remain with faith and tender devotion before the Eucharist, and converse familiarly with Jesus Christ, who is there for the express purpose of listening to and graciously hearing those who pray to him." - St. Alphonsus Liguori
