

Saints Who Promoted Eucharistic Adoration

St. Thomas Aquinas (1225-1274) Feast: January 28

One of the most intelligent and wellknown Catholic saints is Thomas Aquinas. He was a Dominican friar and priest who was ultimately designated a Doctor of the Church.



He is possibly the greatest Catholic philosopher and theologian whose impact on our faith was and remains invaluable.

He was a life-long supreme advocate of Eucharistic devotion, and was a scholar who recognized the importance of teaching both the scholarly as well as the simple Catholic worshiper. Aquinas played a major role initiating the feast of The Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). It was Aquinas who wrote the initial liturgy in 1264.

Early in his career he began writing what would be called his Supreme Doctrine in which one of the first things he addressed was the Eucharist. His Eucharistic doctrine continues to be totally embraced by the Church.

To date, much has been written about Saint Thomas, as he led quite an interesting life. He impacted many aspects of our faith in addition to Eucharistic Adoration, as his writings continue to be an integral part of our faith and are readily available.

"The Blessed Eucharist is the perfect Sacrament of the Lord's Passion, since it contains Christ Himself and his Passion. The proper effect of the Eucharist is the transformation of man into God." - Saint Thomas Aquinas




