The role of the Finance Council is to advise the pastor on matters relating to the financial management of the parish. We review and approve the annual church budget and review monthly revenue and expenses. Each year your Finance Council is charged with the responsibility to report the financial condition of the parish to our parishioners. Construction of the Parish Activity Center began this fiscal year and will soon be complete. Funds collected from the Building Fund, the Auction and Festival, and the Generation to Generation Campaign were used to reduce the amount of funds borrowed from the Diocese of Baton Rouge, which will reduce the amount of interest that we will have to pay in the future. Your continuing donations to our Building Fund will be used for ongoing maintenance needs as well as the new Parish Activity Center. Once the final amount has been calculated, we will provide more information on costs and repayment of the loan.

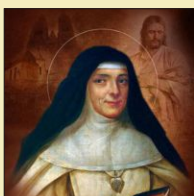

Saints Who Promoted Eucharistic Adoration

St. Mary Euphrasia (1796-1868)

Feast: April 24

St. Mary Euphrasia was born off the west coast of France. When her father died in 1810, she was taken from her family and sent to a boarding school in Tours. Unlike her former joyful and carefree life, her new life consisted of discipline, which was mostly prohibitions and warnings.



Her first documented encounter with God took place during her adolescence. She first realized that God loved her with a love "beyond comprehension" while she was totally ostracized from her family. She had recurring dreams of God telling her: "Whoever you are, and whatever you do, you are loved."

Her Contemplation of the Heart of God was expressed in three inseparable devotions: to the Sacred Heart, to the Eucharist, and to the Blessed Virgin.

The spiritual life of St. Mary Euphrasia can be characterized by a deep union with the Lord, and by the incessant intercession to the Good Shepherd. She wanted people to welcome His love and become involved in building His Kingdom here on earth.
