#### **Featured Saint of the Week**

St. Pier Giorgio Frassati 4/6/1901-7/4/1925 Feast Day 7/4

Today's saint is the second of two (along with Carlo Acutis) who were canonized on September 7, 2025. Both are recognized for their focus on youth.

Frassati was born to well-connected parents. His father was an agnostic who owned a liberal newspaper; his mother was



a very talented artist whose work was lauded by King Victor Emanue III.

Frassati's helping others dated back to his childhood. He answered the door one day to find a mother begging with her son who was barefooted. He took off his own shoes and gave them to the boy.

After his Jesuit education, he became deeply involved with a number of groups promoting various topics. Each group's focus was to unite people in fellowship to combat inequalities. One of the groups was the Apostleship of Prayer and Catholic action. He also joined the Third Order of St. Dominic, as well as the St. Vincent de Paul Conference. He often said: "Charity is not enough, we need social reform".

When he graduated school, his father offered him either a car or a sizable fund. He chose the money to help fund his many ongoing projects.

Frassati was an avid mountaineer and athlete who could swim well. In June of 1925 while boating with two friends, he began to complain of sharp pains in his back muscles. He returned home with a severe headache and fever. But on that same day, his maternal grandmother had died. He chose to remain quiet. The very next day a doctor was called. The doctor asked Frassetti to get up from his lying down position. Frasseti replied, "I can't!" He was diagnosed with polio. Two days later he succumbed to the disease. He was 25. The streets were lined with thousands of people honoring him on the day of his funeral.

St. John Paul II dubbed him the "Man of the Eight Beatitudes.




#### The Eucharistic Miracles of the World
