

Saints Who Promoted Eucharistic Adoration

St. Gregory the Great (540-604)

Feast: September 3

Pope Gregory I, a former prefect of Rome and monk, likewise compiled and advanced liturgical traditions, bringing the Roman rite to a stable form and perfecting its musical tradition, giving his name to Gregorian chant. He also advocated celebrating Masses for the souls in purgatory. One of his Masses occasioned a Eucharistic miracle and the depiction of the Mass of St. Gregory, making the Pope a witness to Christ's true presence. Through all of his efforts, he is rightly considered one of the fathers of Europe and a key creator of the culture of Christendom that grew up surrounding the Mass. He witnesses to the need for beauty in our celebration of the Mass.
