


Saints Who Promoted Eucharistic Adoration

St. Anthony Mary Claret (1807-1870)

Feast: October 24

St. Anthony Claret was born in a town on the outskirts of Barcelona, Spain. He was fifth of eleven children. He was a very talented and busy priest and missionary throughout his life.



Although born in Spain, his work took him to the Canary Islands, Cuba,

Madrid, Paris, and the first Vatican Council. His priestly duties called him to become a missionary, religious founder, social reformer, chaplain to Queen Isabella II of Spain, writer and publisher, archbishop, and refugee.

For many years St. Anthony gave popular missions and retreats, always placing great emphasis on the Eucharist and the Immaculate Heart of Mary. He never traveled without his rosary. The religious institute of missionaries he founded exists today, known as the Claretians.

While confessor to the Queen, the outbreak of war sent him into exile in France. Unfortunately, St. Anthony died while in exile. Years later, his remains were ultimately returned to his home in Spain.

Throughout his life St. Anthony continuously defended and helped the poor and downtrodden.


