Featured Saint of the Week

St. Francis Borgia (1510-1572)

Feast Day: October 10

Francis was born in Spain into a family steeped in nobility and wealth. Growing up, he wanted to become a monk however his parents chose to send him off to serve in the court of King Charles I of Spain.

In 1529, he married a Portuguese noble woman, with whom he parented eight children. While married, Francis was appointed to various positions within the monarchy. Upon his father's death in 1543, Francis inherited the position of the 4th Duke of Grandia. In that position when he was unable to arrange a marriage that would enjoin Portugal and Spain; he felt like a failure.

Francis' wife died in 1546, devastating him. Just after his wife's death, he became detached from the court. He realized that he'd lived with a vanity of life and all its grandeur. He wanted to devote himself to religious activities. He organized his affairs then abdicated in favor of his son.

He decided to enter the newly formed Society of Jesus (Jesuits). He was ordained in 1551 and became involved in the establishment of what is now the Gregorian University in Rome. He went on to deliver sermons which were motivating revival of the faith in the country.

Borgia got wind of the real potential that he would be named a cardinal. With the help of his friend, Ignatius of Loyola he secretly left the area and traveled to northern Spain. While there Borgia founded a number of colleges, and was elected as the 3rd Superior General of the order, plus he also supervised all of the affairs of the rapidly growing order.

His insatiable zeal led him to establish missions in Florida, New Spain, and Peru, thus extending the order's reach even to the New World.

St. Francis Borgia died 9/30/1572 from pneumonia, at the age of 61.
