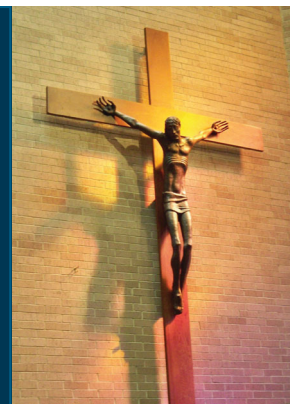

Stewardship of Finance Report

The role of the Finance Council is to advise the pastor on matters relating to the financial management of the parish. We review and approve the annual church budget and review monthly revenue and expenses. Each year your finance council is charged with the responsibility to report the financial condition of the parish to our parishioners. 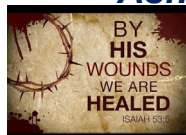
