World Marriage Day honors husband and wife as the foundation of the family. It salutes the beauty of their faithfulness, sacrifice and joy in daily married life.

The idea of celebrating marriage began in Baton Rouge in 1981, when couples encouraged the Mayor, the Governor and the Bishop to proclaim St. Valentine's Day as "We Believe in Marriage Day." The event was so successful, the idea was presented to and adopted by Worldwide Marriage Encounter's National Leadership.

By 1982, 43 Governors officially proclaimed the day and celebrations spread to U.S. military bases in several foreign countries. In 1983, the name was changed to "World Marriage Day", designated to be celebrated each year on the second Sunday in February. In 1993, his Holiness, Pope John Paul II, imparted his blessings on World Marriage Day.

Father, as we prepare for World Marriage Day, we thank you for your tremendous gift of the Sacrament of Marriage. Help us to witness to its glory by a life of growing intimacy. Make us grow more in love with the Church so we may renew the Body of Christ. Make us a sign of unity in the name of Jesus, our Lord and Brother. Amen.

A Minute with the Deacon

Should I bring my small children to sit in the pews with me during Mass? They might cry and disrupt the congregation.

It is appropriate, in fact you are encouraged, to bring your child into the Church during Mass, regardless of their age. This will help form your child’s faith and help them to be able to fully participate in the Eucharistic celebration. They are the Church as much as the rest of us; we are all one body.

Here are some tips:

- Feed your child a good breakfast before Mass, high in protein and low in sugar.
- For toddlers, change their diaper before leaving for Mass.
- Pack a special “Church” bag. Include a religious themed book, colors and a coloring book and diapers, if needed.
- Arrive early to get your child settled in the pew.
- Sit in one of the first pews so that they can see what is going on. This will help them understand what is taking place. Help them participate. Sometimes, you might want to quietly explain what is happening.
- If the child gets fidgety, hold them until they quiet down. Bring them to the “Day Chapel/Quieting Room” only in case of meltdowns or emergencies. Don’t put them down and let them play. They might realize that they can play, if they are disruptive.
- If your child cries during Mass, that’s OK. When I lived in Houma, my wife and I went to a small church down the bayou. During Father’s homily one Sunday, there were several babies crying. He stopped his homily and said “Don’t worry about the babies crying. They are just saying their prayers!”
- If your child has been good, praise them after Mass.
- Set a positive example.
- Be patient!!!

Many parishioners love to see small children at Mass. Don’t be surprised if some thank you for bringing them to Mass. One of your jobs is to pass the faith on to your child. You might feel that you are not getting much out of Mass with your child, but do the best you can, and let God do the rest.
