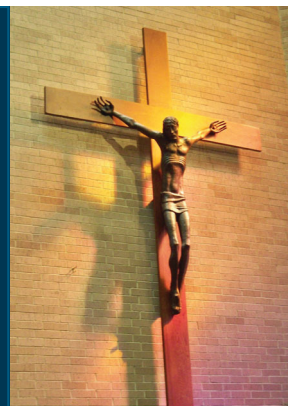

St Alphonsus Ladies Altar Society Trip



We will travel by motor coach to St. Mary's of False River and St. Francis of Point Coupee Chapel on Tuesday, April 24. The bus will load at 8:30 a.m. at St. Alphonsus and arrive at St. Francis of Point Coupee Chapel at 9:30 a.m. This church was originally built in 1728, although the location had to be moved and rebuilt multiple times due to the Mississippi River.



Lunch will be at Satterfield's Restaurant (included in cost). Cost of trip is \$30 for members and \$40 for non-members.

After lunch, we will arrive at St. Mary's of False River around 2 p.m. This church was a mission church of St. Francis until after the Civil War when it became an independent parish in 1865.
