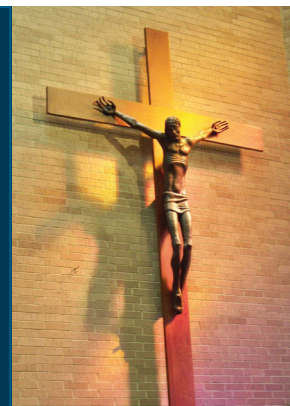

Palm Sunday— March 25



Holy Week begins with joy and acclamation. This Sunday is the triumphant entry of Jesus into his own city of Jerusalem. It emphasizes that the three elements—suffering, death, and resurrection—belong together. Jesus' death was not a defeat. It was a victory. It is the unique insight of Christianity that the events of Jesus's earthly life were to carry out God's saving purpose. On this day, the Church celebrates Christ's entrance into Jerusalem to accomplish God's will of death and resurrection.

Chrism Mass— Wednesday, March 28



The Chrism Mass will be celebrated at St. Joseph Cathedral at 10:30 AM. Bishop Muench will bless all the sacred oils used in the churches of our diocese. Priests will recommit themselves to the service of God's people, while the laity recommit themselves to the service of the Church. Bishop Muench requests that as many laity as possible attend this special service.



Holy Thursday — March 29

The Mass of the Last Supper of Jesus Christ signals the end of Lent and the beginning of the Easter Triduum. The Last Supper was when Jesus established the sacrament of Holy Communion prior to his arrest and crucifixion. It also commemorates His institution of the priesthood. Today's Gospel is the story of Jesus washing the disciples' feet. It proclaims that our Eucharist is verified in our acts of loving service and in our ministering to one another as Jesus ministered to his chosen friends.

Good Friday— March 30

Good Friday is the day on which Catholics honor the crucifixion of Jesus Christ. Catholics are joined by almost all other Christians in solemn commemoration on this day. Friday's liturgy focuses on the cross, and we celebrate the victory of Jesus on the cross on which He died to bring us eternal life.

Holy Saturday — March 31

The Triduum continues with a day of waiting, prayer, fasting, and emptiness as we prepare for the day of Resurrection. The spirit of the Church is one of waiting, as the holy women who sat by the tomb did. Baptism is the keynote of Saturday's Vigil. The Church will baptize the Elect and receive the Candidates into our Church community. We are called to experience the victory of resurrection by renewing our baptismal promises and being sprinkled with new Easter water.

Easter Sunday — April 1

Easter is the celebration of Christ's resurrection from the dead. It is celebrated on Sunday, and marks the end of Holy Week, the last day of the Easter Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday), and is the beginning of the Easter season of the liturgical year. His resurrection marks the triumph of good over evil, sin and death. It is the singular event which proves that those who trust in God and accept Christ will be raised from the dead. The liturgies will focus on baptism and our resurrection to new life in Christ.
