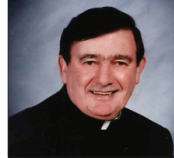

May Your Easter Be Joyful By Fr. Mike Moroney

The six weeks of Lent have moved rather quickly, and now we are in the beautiful season of Easter. It is that very special time when we celebrate God's love for us in all of its fullness in the resurrection of Christ. FORMATION

Stump the Deacon

As requested by Canon Law, Bishop Robert Muench submitted his resignation as our bishop on his 75th birthday in December. What is the procedure for the appointment of a new bishop?

The point-man in the process is the pope's ambassador to the United States (the apostolic nuncio). He obtains a list of nominees from his own file of potential candidates and recommendations from Louisiana bishops and the Archbishop of New Orleans.

The apostolic nuncio conducts his own investigation which includes reviewing a report from the current bishop and his recommendations. The Archbishop and all Louisiana bishops are contacted; additionally the leadership of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) is consulted. The nuncio may also seek the opinion of others, including the laity. The nuncio narrows the list and sends a questionnaire to people who know each candidate. After reviewing the information received, he reduces the list to three and forwards the list to the Congregation for Bishops in Rome with his preference noted.

The Congregation discusses the appointment. The Congregation may follow the recommendation of the nuncio, add or delete or re-rank the candidates or even ask for more names. Eventually, they agree on their list of three names, ranked in order of their preference.

The head of the Congregation presents its recommendations to the pope. The pope typically chooses from the list, but is free to name anyone else or send the matter back for more recommendations. After the Pope makes his decision, the Congregation notifies the nuncio, who in turn contacts the candidate. If the candidate accepts, the Vatican is notified and a date is set for the announcement.

Recently, the process from vacancy to the announcement of a new bishop has taken as little as three months to as many as eighteen months.

One of our games at the fair utilizes play money. If you have paper play money from games you no longer use, please send it to us through the church and/or school office.

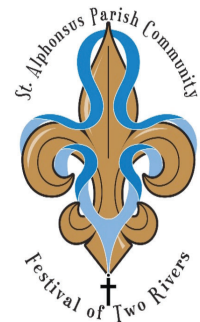
