

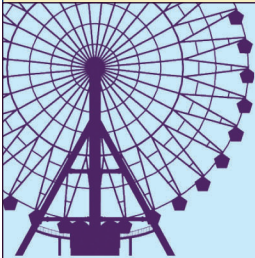

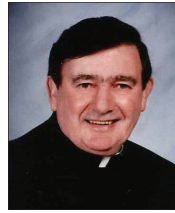

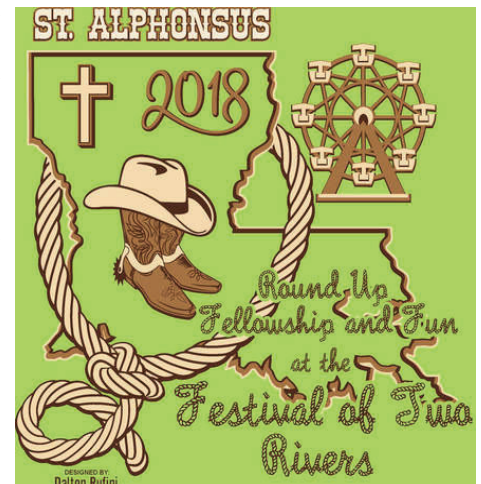
**Everyone is invited to the

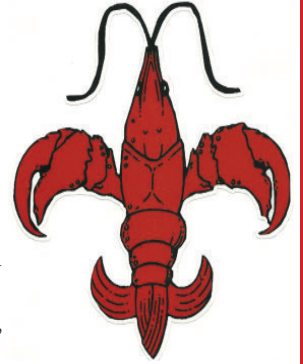
