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Be a Life Saver- Part 2

In last week's article I wrote about reasons, mainly physically and emotionally, to donate blood. In this article, I want to explore the spiritual reasons.

From the Bible we know that blood is considered very special. During our celebration of the Eucharist we partake of the blood of Jesus. In many cultures blood is a symbol for life. Indeed, Jesus' crucifixion, the shedding of His Blood was to give us life.

Spiritually speaking, the Eucharist is the heart of the Church's life. Christ's presence in this sacrament sustains us throughout all joys and sorrows. This presence is made available to us daily through the Mass where we are infused into the powerful instruments of God's work and become spiritually nourished believers. Likewise, a person suffering with illness needs the transforming power of blood to have a chance of continued life. This blood comes from the sacrifice of another. Just as Christ shed His blood for us, so too are we called to share what sustains us with another in dire need.

What if it was you or your family member that needed blood and there was none? Most of us think it could not happen here, in America, in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. Only poor countries do not have the resources to keep a blood supply. This is not true.

There have been at least two times that the blood donations done at this church has seen OLOL Blood Services through low donation periods. Because of the generosity of our parishioners, the Blood Bank did not have to buy blood from other vendors to meet the need. Donations tend to go in cycles, summer and holidays donations decrease. The need increases during summer when outdoor accidents are more prevalent. Donors make a difference. How about you? Can you make a difference? Absolutely- a difference between life and death. Be a LIFE SAVER! Give blood! Our next blood drive is May 6, 2018 in the St. Francis Room from 8AM-2PM.
