FORMATION

Stump the Deacon

I have heard the term "Paschal Mystery." What does that mean?

When we recite the Nicene Creed at Mass, we acknowledge the Paschal Mystery of our salvation. There are three parts to the Paschal Mystery:

- Jesus' passion and death;
- His resurrection;
- His ascension into heaven.

In the Nicene Creed we pray:

"For our sake He was crucified under Pontius Pilate; He suffered death and was buried." (Jesus' passion and death)

"[He] rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. (His resurrection)

"He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father." (His ascension into heaven)

Because there are three distinct parts to the Paschal Mystery, the Church gives us a lot of time to experience it, to "bask in the moment," about 50 days from the beginning of the passion until the celebration of the Ascension of our Lord into heaven. During this time, our Lord prepared His followers, and now prepares us, to share in this mystery by proclaiming it, sharing it, and celebrating it.

Pope Francis Documentary

On May 18, 2018, the documentary "Pope Francis: A Man of His Word" opens in theaters nationwide, giving audiences a chance to feel as if they just met Pope Francis in person. Co-produced with the Vatican's Office of Communication, this movie is not *about* Pope Francis, but *from* him, directly addressing the audience as if sitting face-to-face with them. The result is truly one of a kind, a personal and intimate visit with the Pope like you've never seen before on film.
