## A MINUTE WITH THE DEACON

*Hurricane season started June 1st. Many of our prayers asking us to be spared from hurricanes are addressed to Our Lady of Prompt Succor. Why?*

“Prompt succor” is French for “quick help.” For over 200 years, the Ursuline Sisters of New Orleans have shared their devotion to Our Lady of Prompt Succor with those who pray to the Mother of God for “quick help” in moments of pain or need, joy or thanksgiving, and deliverance from wars, fire, pestilence, disease, storms, despair and hopelessness. During hurricane season many prayers are offered to her seeking her protection from these storms. One such hurricane prayer follows:



*Our Father in heaven, through the powerful intercession of Our Lady of Prompt Succor, spare us from all harm during this hurricane season and protect us and our homes from all disasters of nature. Our Lady of Prompt Succor, hasten to help us. Amen*

The National Shrine of Our Lady of Prompt Succor is located on Nashville Avenue in New Orleans. It houses the statue of Our Lady of Prompt Succor that came to New Orleans in 1810. How and why it came to New Orleans will be discussed in an upcoming bulletin.

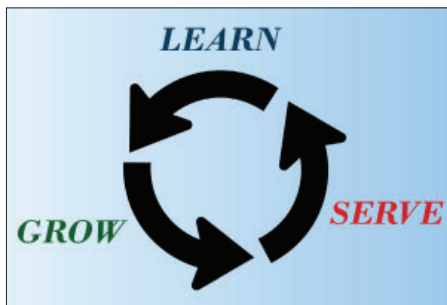
