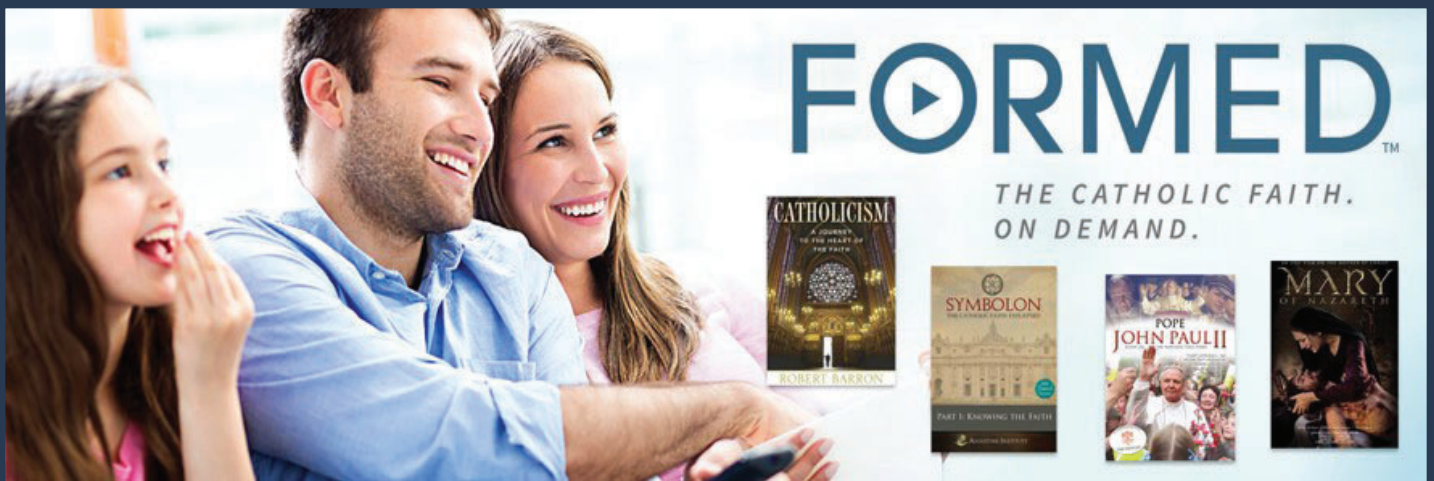

Church and School Receive Dividends from Auction & Festival of Two Rivers By Fr. Mike Moroney

Our parish and school each received a check this past week from our Auction and Festival of Two Rivers fundraisers. The total for both events this year was \$415,000.00, and after expenses, the church and school each received \$130,000.00. Many thanks to those who worked on both committees, all of the volunteers and all who supported these two very successful events.

As we approach the Fourth of July, it is a time to be grateful and thankful for the many men and women who have served in the cause of freedom and those who continue to risk their lives each day. Because of terrorism, our lives have changed when we travel, go to sporting events, and in particular, when we fly.

Every time you and I watch the news, life seems so dispensable with the wave of crime that takes place in our nation each day. On this Fourth of July as we celebrate our freedom, new challenges have arisen in our country for law enforcement and for all of us. We deal with the ongoing issue of safety. For more than a decade, particularly during the past few years, we have seen most of the world's ethnic, religious and national struggles disintegrate into war and violence in many countries. We have also seen an increase in crime in neighborhoods previously not affected by crime. More and more, we are confronted with this issue at all levels of society. Life is no longer held up with the dignity and sacredness it once had; it has become disposable. This should raise issues for all of us as we need to work to restore that great dignity which has eroded over the years.

While September 11 is becoming more a memory for many, it still continues to raise issues for our president, for government leaders, for our security forces and all in leadership as to how to deal with hate and anger in the world, in our country, our schools, and our society.

For us Catholics, these issues raise questions for us as to how to deal with anger, bullying, forgiveness and how to create a better society.

Crime and hate have nothing to do with God's love. Saint John Paul II put it this way: "Violence is always an offense, an insult to man, both to the one who perpetrates it and to the one who suffers it."

As Christians, we cannot allow violence and anger to rule our world. R.D. Lang, a Christian author, said many years ago, "We are effectively destroying ourselves by violence masquerading as love."

As Catholics, I believe we are called to be the messengers of goodness on this Fourth of July. We cannot allow the freedom so bravely fought for to be taken away by anger, violence and crime in our communities. Let us all act and pray for peace in our lives, our country and our world.

Changing topics for a moment- From July 15 to August 16, I will be in Ireland visiting with my family. Again I thank Fr. Arun John, who will be taking my place. Fr. John worked with me for four years when I was pastor at Our Lady of Mercy. You will enjoy him during his time here with you. With such a priest shortage in our Diocese and very few parishes with two priests, it is a challenge to be able to cover weekend Masses, so I am most grateful to Fr. John for his generosity. Fr. John will also be available for the daily Mass schedule and for funerals or any other needs. Have a blessed week.

Vacation Bible School

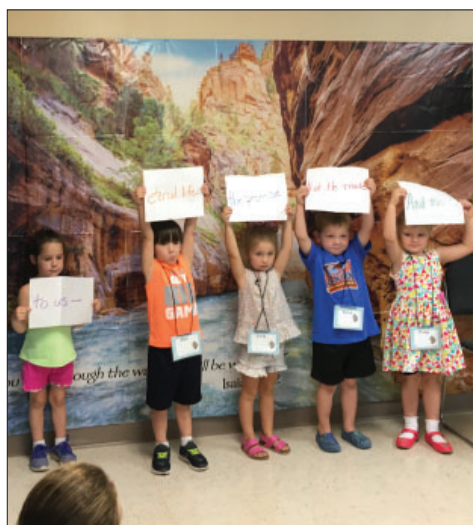

A MINUTE WITH THE DEACON

Hurricane season started June 1st. Many of our prayers asking us to be spared from hurricanes are addressed to Our Lady of Prompt Succor [Our Lady of Quick Help]. Why? (Part 2)

In 1727, French Ursuline nuns founded a monastery in New Orleans, and began to organize schools in the area. In 1803, short on teachers, Sister Andre Madier requested more sisters from France. She wrote her cousin, Sister Michel Gensoul, who was running a Catholic boarding school for girls. The matter was referred to Bishop Fournier of Montpelier, France. Because of the repressions of the French Revolution he was short-handed, so he declined to send any sisters. Sister Michel was given permission to appeal to the Pope. At this time, Pope Pius VII was a prisoner of Napoleon, and it seemed unlikely he would even receive her letter of petition. Sister Michel prayed:

O most Holy Virgin Mary, if you obtain for me a prompt and favorable answer to this letter, I promise to have you honored at New Orleans under the title of Our Lady of Prompt Succor.

She sent her letter on March 19, 1809. Against all odds, she received a response on April 29, 1809. The Pope granted her request, and Sister Michel commissioned a statue of Our Lady of Prompt Succor holding the Infant Jesus.

Sister Michel and several postulants came to New Orleans on December 31, 1810. They brought the statue with them, and placed it in the convent chapel in the French Quarter. Since then, Our Lady of Prompt Succor has interceded for those who have sought her help.
