Faith Formation

We offer two opportunities for P.S.R. These options are designed to help the children in our parish grow in their understanding of our Catholic Faith.

AT HOME - Religion classes for Students in K - 12 grade in public or private school.

In this option, parents provide faith formation in their home using a text book and instructional manual. Parents work with their child(ren) to complete the assignments. The parents and young people attend five meetings that provide information, answer questions, and assess their understanding and progress.

At Home meetings are from 7:00 – 8:30 PM

LEARNING GROUPS – Religion classes for Students in K –12 grade in public or private school.

This is a conventional classroom setting facilitated by a catechist. Young people are educated by use of textbooks, music, videos, etc. to enhance their understanding and knowledge of our Catholic Faith.

Learning Group sessions are scheduled from 5:30 - 7:00 PM Sunday evenings.

CONFIRMATION All 10th and 11th Grade students in P.S.R. or a Catholic High School must register each year for these sessions.


