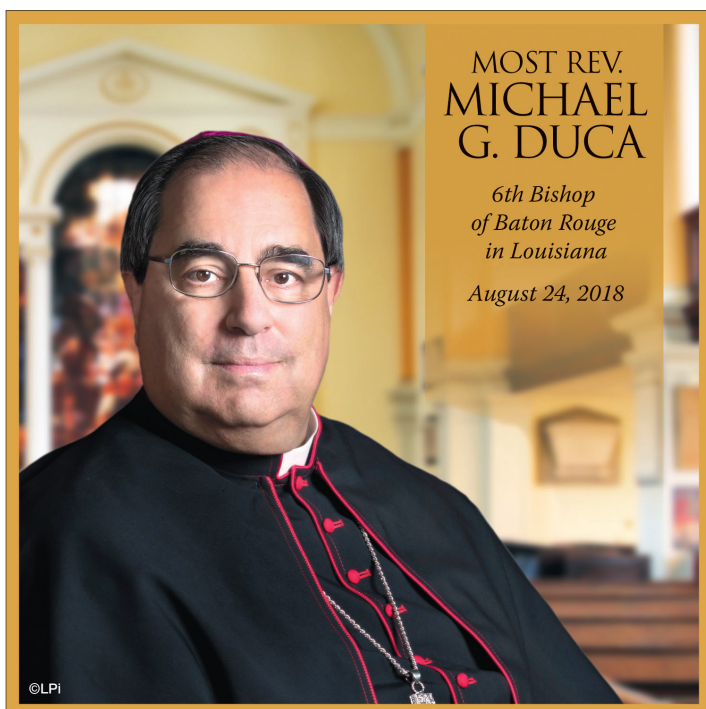
### Children's Liturgy

### A Minute with the Deacon

*What is the origin of the "sign of the cross?"*

The July/August 2018 issue of Catholic Answers Magazine addressed the issue of the origin of the "sign of the cross":

"The earliest reference to making a 'sign of the cross' comes from the Church Father Tertullian, who described around the year A.D. 211 how Christians make a small sign of the cross on their foreheads. He writes 'In all our travels and movements, in all our coming in and going out, in putting on our shoes, at the bath, at the table, in lighting our candles, in lying down, in sitting down, whatever employment occupy us, we mark our foreheads with the sign of the cross.' In the fourth century, the small forehead sign of the cross developed into the larger sign that involves the head, chest, and shoulders."
