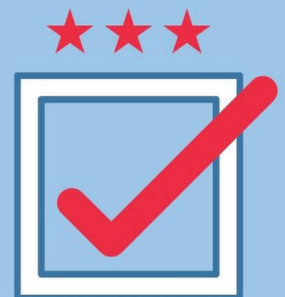
## Presidential Election Voting November 3, 2020
