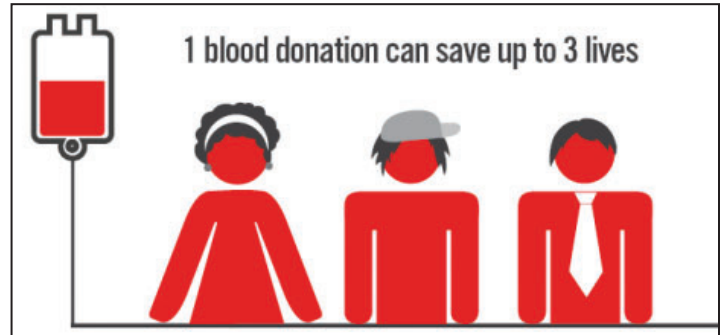
Veterans Mass

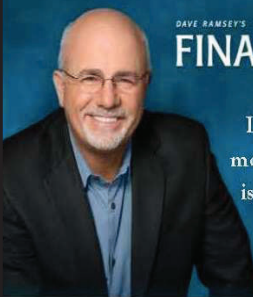
Homebound? Need Holy Communion?

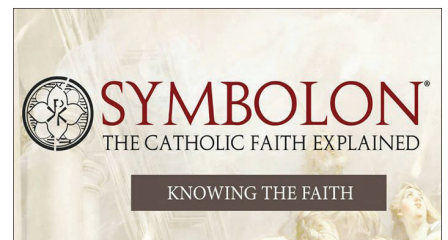
Theology On Tap
