What are Benediction and Adoration?

“Of all devotions, that of adoring Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament is the greatest after the sacraments, the one dearest to God, and the one most helpful to us.” -St. Alphonsus Liguori

Exposition and benediction of the Blessed Sacrament is not only a very old devotion in our Church, but one that highlights the fundamental mystery of the holy Eucharist — that our Lord is truly present, body and blood, soul and divinity in the Blessed Sacrament.

Benediction:

- A form of worship and thanksgiving instituted out of love for Christ
- The consecrated Host is exposed in the monstrance on the altar for adoration
- Music and incense are incorporated to help us reflect on the sacredness of the celebration
- The celebrant’s hands do not touch the monstrance, reflecting the fact that the blessing is being received as if Jesus was standing before us
- Near the end, the celebrant blesses the congregation with the monstrance
- Benediction is usually scheduled since a priest or deacon is needed.

Adoration:

- From the beginning Christians have believed that the bread and wine become his very Body and Blood
- During Adoration we focus on Christ’s presence in the Eucharist
- Spending quiet time before the exposed Eucharist for private prayer and reflection

“Adoration is meant to inspire the Christian to connect himself or herself to the actual celebration for the Mass. In our heart Eucharist Adoration should never be separate from the Mass but flowing from and leading to that which the Second Vatican Council called “the summit and the font of the Church’s spiritual life.”

A Minute with the Deacon

Do the saints really hear our prayers?

Mary and the saints do hear our prayers. This is supported by scripture.

Even though they have left this earth, Mary and the saints are not dead, as we normally think of death. Jesus said "And concerning the resurrection of the dead, have you not read what was said to you by God, 'I am the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob'?" He is not the God of the dead but of the living." (Matthew 22:31-32) Jesus is telling us that the saints are alive in heaven, probably more alive than we are on earth. Their ability to hear should be better than ours.

In the letter to the Hebrews, the author states "Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses [in other words, those faithful who have died before us] let us rid ourselves of every burden and sin that clings to us and persevere in running the race that lies before us." In other words, those in heaven surround us like spectators at a race; therefore, they must know about us and can see our earthly struggles from heaven. (Hebrews 12:1)

The Book of Revelation probably gives the best scriptural evidence that our prayers to the saints in heaven are heard. Revelation states that "the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each holding a harp, and with golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints." (Revelation 5:8) In first century biblical sense, the term "saints" was commonly used as meaning those on earth who have accepted Christ. Revelation 8:3-4 goes on to state that the prayers of the saints on earth rise with the prayers of the saints in heaven "from the hand of the angel before God." To rephrase these passages: "The saints in heaven assist the praises and petitions of the saints of earth."

But, how can a saint in heaven, like Mary or any other saint, hear and understand the prayers of millions of Catholics in many different languages being offered at the same time? See next week's bulletin for the answer.
