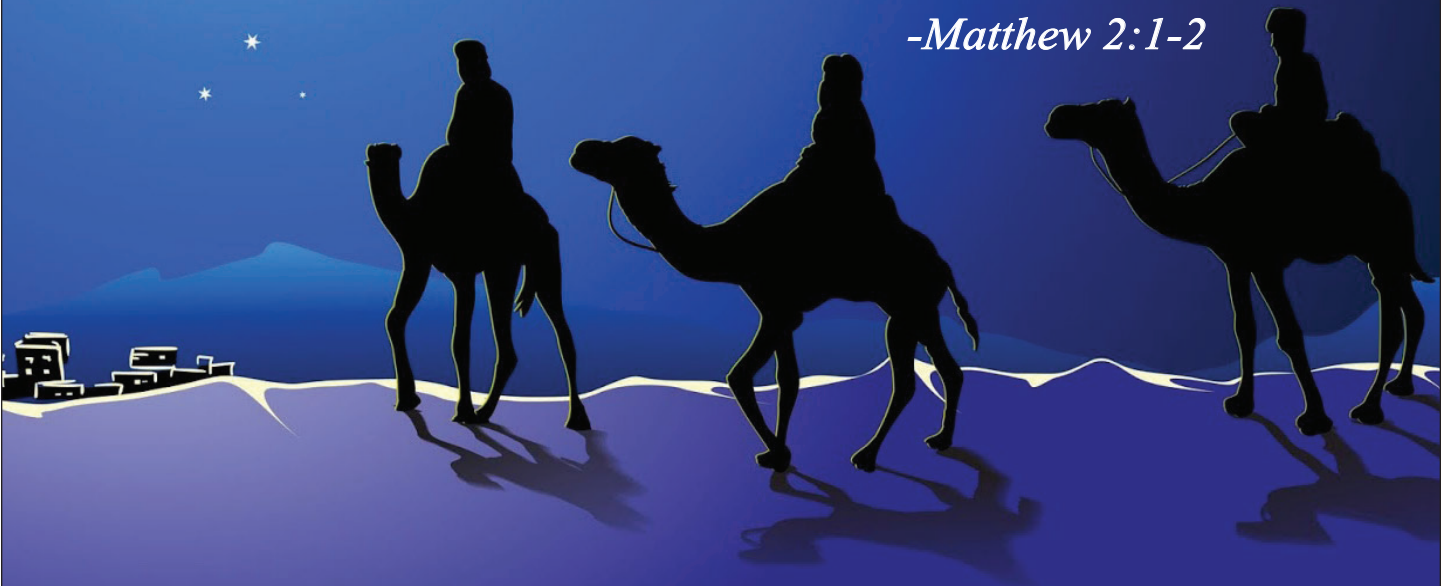

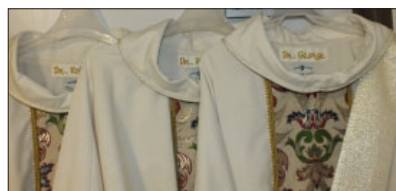

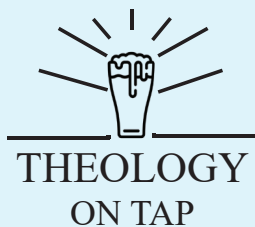
### Adult Confirmation
