

Responsibilities for VBS Teen Helpers

Thank you for volunteering to help with VBS! Your role is important to the success of our VBS week. Here is a list of responsibilities for our teen helpers.

- 1) Help with decorations and set up the week prior to the start of VBS & help with clean up at the end of VBS week.
- 2) Help out and participate in your assigned area.
- 3) Be here at 8:30 AM all of VBS week
- 4) No carrying children. They need to walk
- 5) No cell phone usage (phone calls or texting) while helping with VBS

Listed below are the different areas where you will be asked to volunteer. Each area has daily duties. Please be familiar with responsibilities for the area you are working.

☐ **Crew leader assistant**

1. assist the adult crew leaders with moving the children to each daily activity
2. assist the children in your group with their activities
3. Remain in the Family Center until all VBS participants have been picked up

☐ **Crafts**

1. Help prepare area for children (set out crafts and supplies)
2. Assist the children with making their crafts
3. Clean up area and prepare for the next day
4. Remain in the Family Center until all VBS participants have been picked up

☐ **Recreation**

1. Help the recreation leader facilitate the games
2. Help children with daily activity
3. Prepare area for next day

☐ **Music**

1. Help children learn the songs daily
2. Sing and use the gestures (sign language) for the VBS songs at large assembly and classroom

☐ **Snacks**

1. Assist the adult leader with set up for each group
2. Assist with serving the children
3. Clean up after each group
4. Prepare area for next day's snacks
