



Featured Saint of the Week

St. Thorlak Thorhallsson (1153-1193) Feast Day: 12/23

St. Thorlak was born into a poor agrarian family, and lived his entire life in Iceland. He dedicated his life to God at a young age.

Thorlak was ordained a deacon before the age of fifteen, and a priest at eighteen. He was sent to France for additional education,



where he focused on both the Rule of Augustine and canon law. He lived in a monastery while in France, and came to enjoy the solitary life.

After completing his formal education, St. Thorlak returned to Iceland, where he had hoped to fade into a quiet, monastic life, but God had other plans for him. Thorlak was appointed Bishop of Skalholt.

St. Thorlak was a pillar of stability in an age where many clerics were lax and careless. Being Bishop, he was asked to address clerical reform, starting with stricter adherence to the Augustinian Rule. He also worked tirelessly to limit simony, clerical incontency, and lay patronage.

Five years after his death, Iceland declared Thorlak the patron saint of their country and its first native saint. In 1984, Pope St. John Paul II added St. Thorlak to the church's official liturgical calendar.

In addition to being the patron saint of Iceland, in recent years St. Thorlak was also named the patron saint of those with autism.

Easter Decor Schedule

Monday, March 25 at 9:30 AM - Change decor. Wrap trees with flowers ad fluff potted plants.

Thursday, March 28 after Holy Thursday Mass - Strip altar and prepare for Good Friday service. Change baskets/towels on altar. Hang white fabric on left wall behind tabernacle. Cover cross with red fabric and crown of thorns. Place stand for small cross on altar wrap with red fabric. Place small cross in back by cry room. Place tall kneeler at base of altar steps and cover with red fabric. Place tomb in back.

Friday, March 29 after Good Friday services - Remove red cloth from cross. Replace with white fabric. Hang Risen Jesus banner on wall behind tabernacle. Place runners on altar, gift, and book table. Hang banners on columns. Place plants and flowers on altar. Place small cross in Gather Space and decorate around it.
