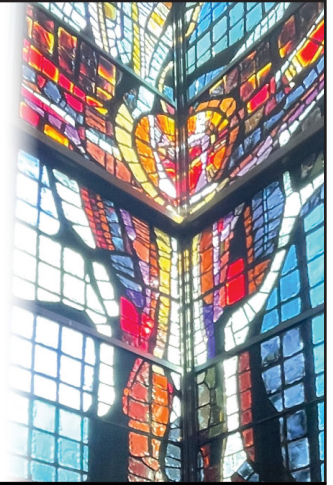

Featured Saint of the Week

St. Jose Gabriel del Rosario Brochero

(3/16/1840 – 1/26/1914)

Feast Day: 1/26

Brochero was born March 16, 1840 in Argentina. At the age of 16, he began studying for the priesthood at the College Seminary of Our Lady of Loreto. His ordination took place on November 4, 1866; he celebrated his first Mass on December 10, 1866.

The next year, Fr. Jose found himself nursing the sick during a cholera epidemic. Brochero started building homes known as Houses of Exercises; they were developed as spiritual retreats, for everyone. He also established a school for girls in 1880. He requested and obtained from the authorities courier posts, post offices, and telegraphic posts in preparation for his planned rail network.

He devoted all his energy to those who required his help. There was not a sick person who was left devoid of the Sacraments. Brochero was known to travel long distances in Argentina on the back of a mule, dressed in a sombrero, a poncho and a gaucho to serve peoples' needs. He carried on the mule his Mass kit, prayer book, and an image of the Virgin Mary. Brochero soon became known as the "Gaucho (cowboy) priest". He was well-known especially for making efforts to improve all aspects of people's involvement in church life.

It was during his travels that he contracted Hansen's disease (leprosy); it was believed that it came from drinking "yerba mate" with one of his patients. He eventually went blind and deaf.

Brochero died on January 26, 1914; his last words were "Now I have everything ready for the journey."

The local Catholic newspaper wrote of him: "It is known that Fr. Brochero contracted the sickness that took him to his tomb, because he visited at length and embraced an abandoned leper of the area."
