April is Devoted to the Holy Eucharist

This month is a perfect time for attending Eucharistic Adoration. While you're there, you can speak to Jesus and tell him all that comes into your mind, read the Bible, pray for those who have hurt you, sit quietly and just BE. Try listening for His voice.

Featured Saint of the Week

Rene Goupil (1608-1642) Feast Day: 10/19

Rene Goupil was born in Anjou, France. He trained to become a surgeon before realizing he would rather the religious life.

His first step toward religious life was to enter the novitiate for the Society of Jesus (the Jesuits). He was prevented from completing his formation because he lost his hearing. With his medical background, Rene knew he would be a valuable asset for the Jesuit missionaries. He was able to do some missionary work with them in Europe.

In 1640 he volunteered to join 40 other people on a mission to the New World. The group included several Huron chiefs and Jesuit priest, Fr. Isaac Joques. They worked in what would become Canada and the future upstate New York. His initial work was in a Canadian hospital providing wound care and blood-letting.

In 1642 the entire group of missionaries were traveling from Canada to New York. Several Indian tribes of the area were at war, and one of those tribes captured the entire group. They were held captive under Indian control.

True to form while in captivity, Rene continued to evangelize. He was seen teaching a Mohawk boy the sign of the cross. Within hours he was tortuously killed.

Before being martyred, Rene professed religious vows as a Jesuit lay brother before Fr. Joques, who also gave Rene absolution before he died.

St. Rene was the first of eight North American martyrs to receive the Crown of Martyrdom, and the first of those martyrs to be canonized.
