### Featured Saint of the Week

**St. Manuel Gonzalez-Garcia**  
(2/25/1877-1/4/1940)

**Feast Day: 1/4**



Gonzalez-Garcia was born in Seville, Spain and had four siblings. When he was a youngster, he joined the church choir in the Cathedral of Seville. At the age of 12, he enlisted in the seminary of Seville as he felt he had a calling to become a priest.

He excelled at his studies, and his teachers held him in high regard. He went on to earn doctorates in both theology and canon law. He was ordained a priest in September of 1901; he celebrated his first Mass on the 29th of September of that year. It was during this Mass that he entrusted himself to the intercession of Mary, Help of Christians.

The next year he was sent to preach a mission in another parish. He found the church to be abandoned, and in need of repair. He knelt before the tabernacle and decided immediately to dedicate himself to Eucharistic works in praise of Jesus Christ.

Gonzalez-Garcia paid careful attention to the disadvantaged people, promoting schools devoted to assisting them and bringing them teachings about the Sacred Heart of Jesus Christ. He was also concerned with the working class, so he orchestrated plans to provide food for the children of people who worked in the mines. This need was heightened even more during a winter miner's strike.

Gonzalez-Garcia, in 1910, established the Disciples of St. John, for those devoted to both the Eucharist and St. John. The order soon spread across all of Europe. He also founded Eucharistic Missionaries of Nazareth, as well as the Children of Reparation. He was appointed Bishop three different times to various areas.

In 1939 while visiting Zargoza, he fell ill and was transferred to Madrid for treatment. He died in 1940 in a clinic and was buried in the Cathedral of Palencia. He asked to be buried there, saying "I ask to be buried next to the tabernacle, so that my bones, after death, as my tongue and my pen in life, are saying to those who pass: there is Jesus! There it is! Do not leave him abandoned.
