Our Lady of Guadalupe Feast Day: December 12

In December 1531, the Virgin Mary, known as Our Lady of Guadalupe, first appeared to Juan Diego near Mexico City. She asked Juan Diego to ask the local bishop to build a church in her honor.



When Juan Diego, an indigenous convert, first approached the bishop, he was very skeptical of his story; he wanted Juan Diego to provide proof that the apparition was real. Our Lady then told Juan Diego to gather roses from the hill and present them to the bishop. Interestingly, it was the middle of winter, and roses were not blooming in December.

Juan Diego did as asked and carried the roses in his cloak (tilma) to show the bishop. When he unrolled the tilma to present the roses, an image of Our Lady of Guadalupe appeared on the fabric. The bishop was speechless and now believed the messenger!

The tilma was made of a very fragile cactus fiber; despite its fragility, it has remained intact for over 500 years. The image itself is considered a miracle; it's described as being iridescent, not painted by human hands. It is said to contain inexplicable details given "16th century technology."

The apparitions and miraculous image are believed to have led to the conversion of literally millions of indigenous people to Catholicism.

The Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico City was built on the site of apparition and is a major pilgrimage destination for Catholics worldwide. Our Lady of Guadalupe is the Patroness of Mexico; she is also venerated by Native Americans. In 1945, Pope Pius XII decreed Our Lady of Guadalupe to be the "Patroness of all the Americas."

Her actual Feast Day is December 12, the date of the first apparition. Her message is that of love and compassion, as well as her promise of help and protection to all mankind.

Are You Prepared for Hurricane Season?


Hurricane season begins on Sunday, June 1, and now is the time to prepare your family for what may come.


