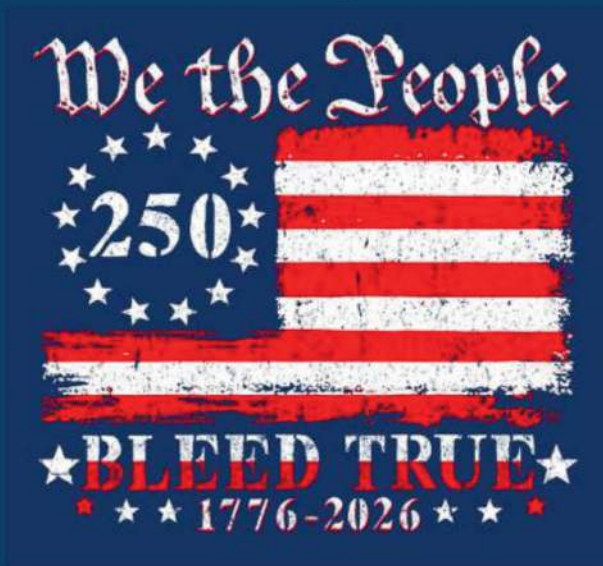

Featured Saint of the Week

St. Hannibal Mary de Francia (7/5/1851 - 6/1/1927)

Feast Day: 6/1



Francia was the second born of four children with noble lineage on both sides. Because Francia lost his father when he was so young (15 mos.), he became very interested in and empathetic toward orphans. He had a great love for and comfort in his heavenly mother Mary. He was a devout child, and with the help of his spiritual advisor he also developed a love of the Eucharist.

Young Francia was known as highly intelligent, with a creative mindset. As soon as he felt the call of God, Francia immediately presented his time and talents to him. He was ordained a priest in March of 1878.

A few months before his ordination, he had a providential moment when he met a blind beggar, who helped him discover the sad social and moral reality of the poor. He visited one of the poorest neighborhoods in the area, which he knew was the beginning of his long walk and boundless love for the poor and the orphans. He truly saw Jesus Christ in each of the poor and marginalized people. He also felt that this message of caring should become worldwide. His next founded two religious congregations: the Daughters of Divine Zeal in 1887, as well as the Rogationists, 10 years later to help spread the word. These organizations continue their cause on every continent today.

He started a daily "Holy Alliance", a prayer movement for vocations. It was supported by orphans, the poor, the priests and religious to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, Mary and Joseph, and the Apostles. He also published a periodical, "God and Neighbor" to involve even more participation.

A few days before his death, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to him assuring his protection, and a vision to reward his devotion to her.

Francia died on June 1, 1927. Crowds of thousands came to mourn the death of this favored son of God.

FORMATION

PSR Registration

Public and private school student's K – 7th are required to register for PSR each year. If your child is in public or private school K-7th grade they will need to register for religion classes. Registration for the 2026-2027 year will begin June 1, 2026, look for registration forms on our website, in the back of the church and in the Faith Formation Office.

Confirmation Registration

All 8-11th grade students that have not received Confirmation are asked to register for sessions in preparation for this sacrament. Registration is open. Forms can be found on the parish website or in the Faith Formation Office.

1st Reconciliation & Eucharist Registration

Parents of 2nd Grade or older are required to register for their children for the sacraments of 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist. Your child must have had one year of religion or have attended one year of Catholic school. Registration for the 2026-2027 year will begin June 1, 2026. Look for registration forms on our website and in the Faith Formation Office.

Inquiry begins in August. Meetings are held on Thursday evenings August through November in the St. Clare Room at 6:30 pm. The classes will transition to OCIA sessions in December. 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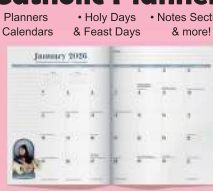
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
