Featured Saint of the Week

St. Marie Alphonsine Danil Ghattas
(10/14/1843 – 325/1927)

Feast Day: 3/25



Sultana Maria was born in Jerusalem to a pious Arab family. At the age of 14, she entered the Congregation of the Sisters of St. Joseph of the Apparition. Upon taking her final vows she took the name Marie Alphonsine.

Her first assignment was to teach at the Sisters' school in Bethlehem, where she was known for her quiet and humble demeanor. Excelling as both a catechist and an educator, she shared her love and devotion to the rosary. It was while she was in Bethlehem that she began having visions of Mary, our Mother. The visions occurred over the course of four years. Our Lady asked Mother Marie Alphonsine to start a new religious order of Arab women devoted to the rosary. She shared these visions only with her spiritual director, Fr. Yousef Tannous.

Fr. Tannous actually started the Congregation of the Dominican Sisters of the Most Holy Rosary of Jerusalem in 1880. Mother Marie Alphonsine had to secure permission to switch orders. She officially became a "Rosary Sister" on the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, on October 7, 1883.

Ghattas devoted her life to parish ministry and the care and education of Palestinian girls; the community grew quickly. She also founded a school for the girls in Beit Sahour. She then did a bit of traveling with three other nuns in the general area to expand her work. At one point she became ill and had to return to Jerusalem. It was in 1917 (after she'd recovered), she founded an orphanage in Ein Karem.

Mother Marie Alphonsine died in Beit Sahour on the Feast of the Annunciation, March 25, 1927. Pope Francis approved her canonization which took place on May 17, 2015.

FORMATION

Classes Begin Soon!

If you have not registered for Faith Formation or Confirmation please pick up a registration form in the back of church, the Faith Formation Office or parish website. Registration forms received after August 1, 2026 take the risk of children not being admitted because classes being full.

PSR Registration

Public and private school student's K – 7th are required to register for PSR each year. If your child is in public or private school K-7th grade they will need to register for religion classes. Registration for the 2026-2027 year will begin June 1, 2026, look for registration forms on our website, in the back of the church and in the Faith Formation Office.

Confirmation Registration

All 8-11th grade students that have not received Confirmation are asked to register for sessions in preparation for this sacrament. Registration is open. Forms can be found on the parish website or in the Faith Formation Office.

1st Reconciliation & Eucharist Registration

Parents of 2nd Grade or older are required to register for their children for the sacraments of 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist. Your child must have had one year of religion or have attended one year of Catholic school. Registration for the 2026-2027 year will begin June 1, 2026. Look for registration forms on our website and in the Faith Formation Office.
