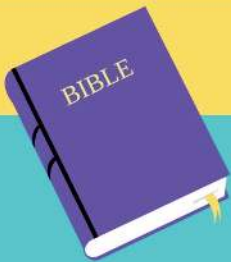

Fr. Jason's Wishful Thinking: School News & Happy 1st Anniversary, Catholic Daughters

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

On June 30, I ended my second year as your pastor, and now begin a third year. Time sure passes quickly, doesn't it? School will resume this month, and St. Alphonsus School will welcome 493 students, including 10 students with special cognitive needs. Two years ago, St. Alphonsus School ended the 2023-2024 school year with 438 students. That means that we are growing and we have indeed reached our capacities in many grade levels. I want to thank Ms. Kristy Monsour, Mrs. Kristin Tate, and the entire faculty and staff for their untiring efforts each day to make St. Alphonsus School the best that it can be. Very soon, Ms. Monsour and I will be sharing the vision and goals that we must accomplish, following the completion of a strategic plan. This months-long process of evaluating the needs of the school has been a collective effort comprised of administration, parishioners, parents and other key stakeholders.

In the summer of 2025, we "resurrected" a historical group at St. Alphonsus—the Catholic Daughters of the Americas (CDA). I have been the state chaplain for CDA for seven years, and it has been a privilege to help plan three state conventions, as well as a national convention in New Orleans. There are many evenings throughout the year that I travel to areas of our state to attend local court meetings and speak on various topics at their invitation. Recently, I went to Cottonport to do a spiritual presentation for their CDA members on the Shroud of Turin. Two weeks ago, I went to my hometown of Plaquemine to attend their CDA anniversary banquet. I was surprised to see Deacon Alfred Ricard in attendance—who was one of my mentors in faith when I was a young man growing up at St. Clement of Rome Church in Plaquemine. The Catholic Daughters of the Americas is a national service organization that aims for Catholic women to mentor other women in being the best that they can be. It was a joy to attend their 61st Biennial National Convention last week in Coralville, Iowa, and to be the main celebrant and homilist at one of the four convention Masses, speaking on the theme of God and Country. How awe-inspiring to hear about the countless projects that 1,000 active courts completed over the last two years! Our new court at St. Alphonsus, Court Mother of Mercy, has accomplished so much in their first year. I want to thank the charter members and the court officers who have demonstrated great patience and resilience in organizing the work of the court over the first few meetings, which was a daunting task.

Catholic Daughters is one of over 60 ministries at St. Alphonsus. In late September, we will be having our stewardship of ministry sign-up weekend. This is a time for all of us to prayerfully consider how we plan to use our gifts in parish life. St. Alphonsus is a very vibrant church when it comes to ministries and a sense of community. It reminds me so much of my former home parish, St. Clement of Rome in Plaquemine, before we had to close it in 2001 due to a lack of priests. As we start to look ahead to ministry sign-ups, I want our parishioners who have been involved in ministries for a long time to take on a mentoring mindset... remember that one day, your watch will end and someone will need to take your place. Don't be too possessive of your ministries or see the new people as "threatening your turf." Think back to the faithful parishioners who mentored you. Let us all begin now in praying how we can be helpful to our church, our community, and our world.

Featured Saint of the Week

St. Giuseppe Allamano (1/21/1851-2/16/1926)
Feast Day: 2/16

Giuseppe Allamano was born into a deeply religious Italian family. For his secondary education, he attended the Oratory of John Bosco. He'd felt he was already being called by God into the priesthood.

Ordained to the priesthood in September of 1873, he was appointed spiritual director at the major seminary of the diocese of Turin. He also continued his education, earning a doctorate in theology. He was then appointed to the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Consolation, a position he held until his death.

During his time there he restructured the sanctuary and had the roof repaired, but he was just getting started. He wanted to ensure the shrine became a source of spiritual renewal. He then added four circular chapels for adequate seating and a better view of the altar. He was also involved in supporting various social initiatives, as well as promoting the Catholic newspapers. He even began publishing his own monthly magazine, *La Consolata*.

While recovering from a serious illness in 1891, he vowed to found a missionary society for priests and laymen. The *Consolata Missionaries* began in 1901. By the next year, missionaries reached Kenya to begin their work. The following year the Sisters of Cottolengo joined the mission. Allamano founded the *Consolata Missionary Sisters* for women.

The Christian population was growing, but there were not enough priests to cater to the pastoral needs of the people. Allamano expressed his concern to Pope Pius X. He urged the pope to do something, suggesting perhaps establish an annual mission day to awaken missionary vocations.

WWI began and took precedence, putting the priest issue on the back burner. During the war, Allamano worked assisting refugees and the seminarians who were drafted.

Allamano died in Turin on February 16, 1926, however his idea for an annual mission day came to fruition a year after he died. Pope Pius XI instituted World Mission Day in 1927, which we still celebrate today.

Classes Begin Soon!

If you have not registered for Faith Formation or Confirmation please pick up a registration form in the back of church, the Faith Formation Office or parish website. Registration forms received after August 1, 2026 take the risk of children not being admitted because classes being full.

PSR Registration

Public and private school student's K – 7 are required to register for PSR each year. If your child is in public, private or a Catholic high school students in 8th, 9th, 10th or 11th grade that have not celebrated the sacrament of Confirmation will need to register for Confirmation classes only. Forms can be found on our website, in the back of the church and in the Faith Formation Office. Registration forms received after August 1, 2026, take the risk of children not being admitted due to class size.

1st Reconciliation & Eucharist Registration

Parents of 2nd Grade or older are required to register for their children for the sacraments of 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist. Your child must have had one year of religion or have attended one year of Catholic school. Registration for the 2026-2027 year will begin June 1, 2026. Look for registration forms on our website and in the Faith Formation Office.
