Featured Saint of the Week

St. Elena Guerra (6/23/1835 – 4/11/1914)

Feast Day: 4/11

Elena Guerra was born into a wealthy and aristocratic Italian family. As a child, she was talented but timid.

Her first job was with the Vincentians, caring for the poor and the sick. During the 1853 cholera epidemic, she was working exclusively with those victims. By 1857, she contracted a disease and was bedridden for six years. She used this time to study French, music, and art. She also studied the lives and works of the Church Fathers. It was during this period that she became a strong proponent of the Holy Spirit, which inspired her to do pious works.

After she'd healed, she established a lay association dedicated to the education of girls under the patronage of the Virgin Mary, St. Joseph, and the patroness of Lucca, St. Zita. She felt a call from the Holy Spirit to dedicate her life and work, particularly to the education of Chinese and African girls.

She next traveled to Rome to attend a session of the First Vatican Council convened by Pope Pius IX. After attending the session, Guerra began writing to Pope Leo XIII, asking that he help to rekindle the faithful devotion to the Holy Spirit. She sent a total of 12 letters. As a result, Pope Leo XIII issued an encyclical in 1897 mandating a worldwide Novena to the Holy Spirit, to be done between the Feast of the Ascension and Pentecost. Guerra also corresponded with Alfred Janssen regarding a "militia of the Holy Spirit" that would work against the Freemasons.

In 1906, the Archbishop of Lucca wanted Guerra to resign as the congregation's leader. He refused to allow her prospective religious to make their vows unless she resigned; in obedience, she did.

The community received papal approval from Pope Pius X in March 1911. Guerra died April 11, 1914 on Holy Saturday. The congregation continues its work worldwide.

Unexpected benefits to joining a Bible Study

PSR Classes Begin Soon!

If you have not registered for Faith Formation or Confirmation please pick up a registration form in the back of church, the Faith Formation Office or parish website. Registration forms received after August 1, 2026 take the risk of children not being admitted because classes being full.

PSR Registration

Public and private school student's K - 7 are required to register for PSR each year. If your child is in public, private or a Catholic high school students in 8th, 9th, 10th or 11th grade that have not celebrated the sacrament of Confirmation will need to register for Confirmation classes only. Forms can be found on our website, in the back of the church and in the Faith Formation Office. Registration forms received after August 1, 2026, take the risk of children not being admitted due to class size.

1st Reconciliation & Eucharist Registration

Parents of 2nd Grade or older are required to register their children for the sacraments of 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist. Your child must have had one year of religion or have attended one year of Catholic school. Registration for the 2026-2027 year is currently open. Look for registration forms on our website and in the Faith Formation Office.

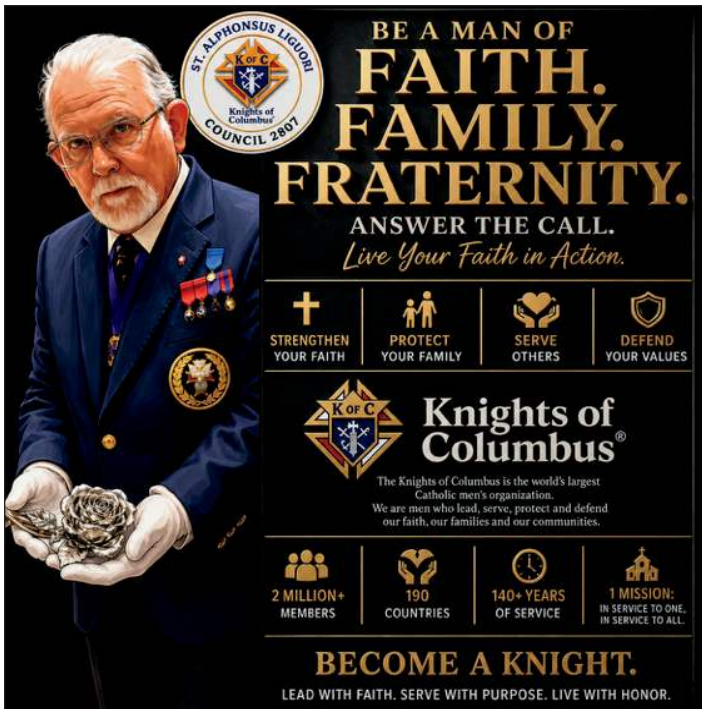

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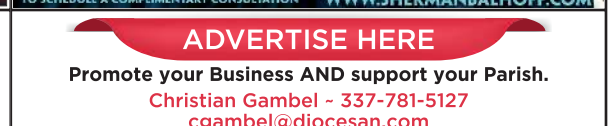
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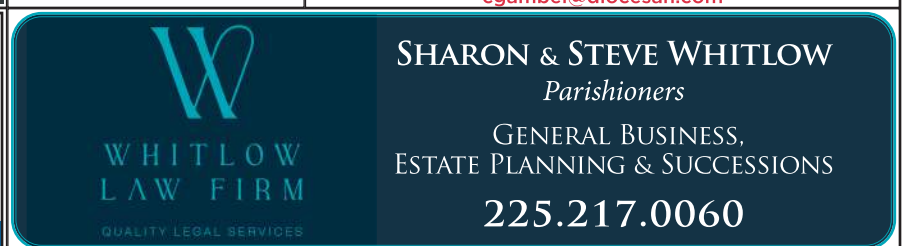
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
